1.3.1 Institution integrates crosscutting issues relevant to Professional Ethics, Gender, Human Values, Environment and Sustainability in transacting the Curriculum

Response:

The curriculum of the university incorporates cross-cutting problems such as gender, sustainability and the environment, human values, and professional ethics. The topics covered in all 15 courses include industrial management, disaster management, air pollution and control, humanities and social sciences, and human rights, entrepreneurship, and soft skills, etc.

Professional Ethics:

As part of their overall growth, students are educated about professional ethics. Encouraging students to enroll in the spoken English course instills professional ethics in them. Interviews on campus are set up to give students the chance to participate in professional ethics training.

Gender:

The University creates an annual action plan for gender sensitization. Women's laws workshops, self-defense classes, and health check-up camps are among the programmes the university offers to female students. Girl's students are encouraged to take part in a variety of events and programmes run by the Women Empowerment Cell, Cultural Department, and National Service Scheme in order to raise awareness of gender issues among students.

Human Values:

All of the institution's faculty members regularly instruct students in the classroom on human values. The college hosts blood donation drives and other events. Great people's birth and death dates are observed, and numerous events are planned in honor of them. Human values are promoted through national holiday celebrations, World AIDS Day demonstrations, etc.

Environment and Sustainability:

The university is in charge of the National Service Scheme (NSS) unit that the institute has formed. The NSS plans environmental and sustainable projects including tree planting, Nala bandhara, and Swachha Bharat Abhiyan. The college hosted a speech about the environment. Second-year students are required to take an Environment course. A neighboring village has been chosen by the NSS department to host a seven-day Special Camp. Programmes pertaining to environmental sustainability are run in the camp. The college held a national conference on environmental awareness and sustainable rural development in India, focusing on issues, solutions, and remedies. The college observes a day without a vehicle. In adopted villages, NSS volunteers worked to save water.
